





RP-459 Partial Tax Exemption for Real Property of Persons with
Disabilities and Limited Income
School Tax Bill **2023-2024**/ Town & County Bill **2024**



Complete the application, making sure...

1.  All resident owners sign and date the application.
2.  Provide a copy of driver's licenses for all owners to prove residency.
3.  Must submit COPIES of 2021 Federal Income Tax Return including your 1040 and all schedules for all owners and spouses of owners, along with 1099 income statements, W2's, all interest, earnings, social security, pensions/annuities, IRA Yearly Statements and all employer compensations (any compensation from employers or prior employers) to verify your income and your enclosed renewal application.
4.  If you do not file Income Tax Return you must submit all 2021 1099 income statements, W2's, all interest, earnings, social security, pensions/annuities, IRA Yearly Statements and all employer compensations (any compensation from employers or prior employers) to verify your income.
5.  Provide a copy of your 2021 IRA End of Year Income Summary, Snapshot or Portfolio and Yearly Statements for all IRA accounts (including Roth) that you hold with or without distributions.

*** If you are applying for the first time, you will need to include a copy of your Award Letter.

The completed original application and all supporting 2021 income documentation must be received in our Assessor's office by March 1, 2023.

- Return your application early to assure your application & documentation is complete by March 1, 2023.
- We will only accept your application with ALL of the required paperwork.
- **THIS EXEMPTION MUST BE RENEWED ANNUALLY**
- OWNERS with INCOME below \$ 58,400 including Social Security may qualify for this exemption. Income limits vary for savings on Town, County, & School taxes.
- If you submit your application by mail, please include an email address to get confirmation it was received in our office. If you want a paper receipt and/or do not have an email address, please send a self-addressed stamped envelope to get a receipt by mail that confirms your application was received.
- You are responsible to bring your own copies. If you can't, a fee will be charged for copies.
